Clinical Director, Inala Indigenous Health Service



A/Professor Noel Hayman was one of the first two Indigenous medical students to graduate from the University of Queensland in 1990.

Noel's current position is Clinical Director of the Inala Indigenous Health Service in Brisbane. Noel has been instrumental in demonstrating how mainstream primary health care services can be made appropriate to the needs of urban Aboriginal populations through the development of the Inala Indigenous Health Service.

His interests include improving Indigenous access to mainstream health services and medical education in the context of Indigenous health. A/Professor Hayman received the 2003 Centenary Medal for his long service to primary health care in Aboriginal communities and the Inaugural Australians for Native Title and Reconciliation Queensland 'Close the Gap Indigenous Health Award' in 2007.

Noel is on numerous National and State Committees including the current Chair of the Royal Australasian College of Physician's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health Expert Advisory Group.
