Dr Colin Tukuitonga is the Chief Executive of the Ministry of Pacific Island Affairs (MPIA) where he provides strategic leadership for the Ministry, building effective bridges between government, agencies and Pacific communities.

Dr Tukuitonga came to MPIA from a position as Associate Professor of Public Health (Pacific and International Health) at the University of Auckland, where he played a key role in establishing the Department of Māori and Pacific Health and Pacific Health Research Centre. Dr Tukuitonga was Head of Surveillance and Prevention of Chronic Diseases for the WHO in Geneva and has held advisory posts with other international agencies including the Secretariat of the Pacific Community and the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific.
