PHC RIS aim:

To work in partnership with the Divisions Network, primary health care researchers and policy makers to create, manage and share information and knowledge that contributes to policy and improves performance.



PHC RIS key roles

Knowledge creation
Knowledge / information management
Knowledge / information sharing



Knowledge creation

- Collect, analyse and synthesise information about activities, performance, outcomes and gaps in Divisions network and primary health care research.
- Conduct applied research that contributes to our understanding of, and capacity to manage and share this information.



Knowledge / information management

- Maintain current databases and data collections
- Establish new database of primary health care research & researchers
- Support users in providing and accessing PHC RIS information
- Implement efficient and effective information management systems



Knowledge / information sharing

- Identify and respond to information needs of stakeholders
- Initiate and take part in multifaceted communication strategies
- Scan environment for relevant information and disseminate
- Provide feedback to assist in improving outcomes and performance
- Enhance collaboration between Divisions, researchers and policy makers

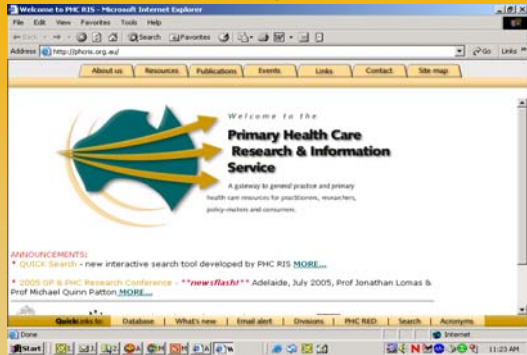
