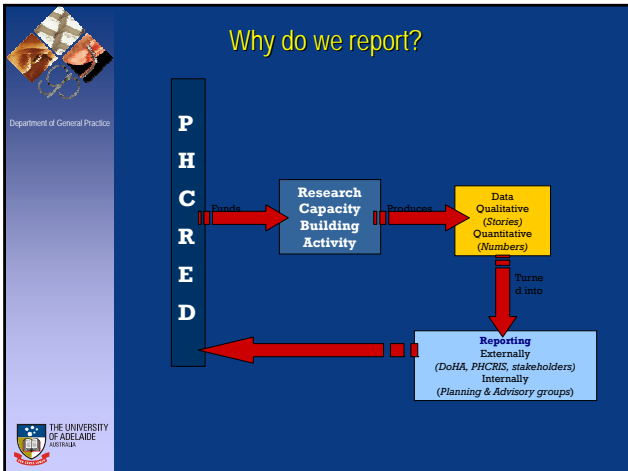

- Report against the Business Plan
- Financial report
- Report as required by Schedule 3, item 1.3





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## Why do we report?

- Measure program progress and effectiveness
- Make sure stakeholders needs are being met
- Allocate resources wisely
- Promote accountability
- Report to the community
- Meet state and national reporting requirements






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## Problems

- Inconsistencies in reporting of activities (e.g. non PHCRED activity)
- Incomplete reporting (e.g. not reporting evaluation activities)
- Difficulty in interpreting measures and activities


